SAMUEL GOLDWYN FILMS ACQUIRES US & LATIN AMERICAN RIGHTS TO CORY BOWLES' FEATURE DEBUT *BLACK COP*STARRING RONNIE ROWE JR.

Los Angeles, CA (**February 6, 2018**) – Samuel Goldwyn Films announced today that the company has acquired US and Latin American rights to Cory Bowles' Psychodrama **BLACK COP**. The film had its world debut at the Toronto International Film Festival and has won multiple awards at festivals in Canada and the US. **BLACK COP** stars Ronnie Rowe Jr. (TV's *StarTrek: Discovery*) and Sophia Walker (TV's *12 Monkeys*).
