## SAMUEL GOLDWYN FILMS ACQUIRES US RIGHTS TO ROBERT MULLAN'S MAD TO BE NORMAL STARRING EMMY AWARD WINNER ELISABETH MOSS AND TV's "DOCTOR WHO" DAVID TENNANT

Los Angeles, CA (September 19, 2017) – Samuel Goldwyn Films announced today that the company has acquired US rights to Robert Mullan's **MAD TO BE NORMAL**. The film stars David Tennant ("Doctor Who"), Emmy Award Winner Elisabeth Moss (Hulu's "The Handmaid's Tale"), Michael Gambon (Harry Potter Franchise), Gabriel Byrne (*THE USUAL SUSPECTS*), David Bamber (*THE KING'S SPEECH*), and Olivia Poulet (*IN THE LOOP*).

David Tennant, of Doctor Who fame, stars as 1960's celebrity psychiatrist R.D. Laing who revolutionised the treatment of people diagnosed as 'mad'. **MAD TO BE NORMAL** reveals the story of R.D. Laing, the famous psychiatrist and one of Scotland's greatest minds. Working out of Kingsley Hall in East London throughout the 1960s and 1970s, Laing performed various daring experiments on people who were diagnosed as mentally disturbed. His revolutionary methods involved experimenting with LSD on his patients and practicing a form of self--healing known as metanoia. This caused outrage and controversy in the medical profession and radically changing attitudes and perceptions of mental health around the world.
