# SAMUEL GOLDWYN FILMS ACQUIRES US RIGHTS TO WIM WENDERS SUBMERGENCE STARRING JAMES MCAVOY AND ALICIA VIKANDER

Los Angeles – November 14, 2017 — Samuel Goldwyn Films announced today that the company has secured the US rights to Oscar-nominated Wim Wender's **SUBMERGENCE**, based on the novel by former war correspondent J.M. Ledgard. The film stars James McAvoy (*X-MEN: First Class, Wanted, and Split*), Alicia Vikander (*A Royal Affair, Ex Machina, The Danish Girl,* and the upcoming *Tomb Raider*), and Celyn Jones (*Set Fire to the Stars, JO*).

James (James McAvoy) is a British agent under the cover of a water engineer, while Danny (Alicia Vikander) is a bio-mathematician working on a deep-sea diving project to explore the origin of life on our planet. On a chance encounter in a remote resort in Normandy where they both prepare for their respective missions, they fall rapidly, and unexpectedly, into each other's arms and a deliriously wild love affair develops, even though their jobs are destined to separate them. Danny sets off on a perilous quest to dive to the bottom of the ocean. James's assignment takes him to Somalia, where he is sucked into a geopolitical vortex that puts him in grave danger. Both characters are subject to different kinds of isolation as they pine for each other; their determination to reconnect becomes as much an existential journey as a love story.

"We were fortunate to see the film at its debut at the Toronto International Film Festival.," says Peter Goldwyn, President of Samuel Goldwyn Films. "We were moved by the story, direction and great performances of its talented cast. We look forward to bringing the film to the US audience in 2018."

"Our film has global dimensions and shows all the beauty of our planet, but also its conflicts and violence. I had Dr. Martin Luther King's words in capital letters on the front page of my script. "You cannot drive out darkness with darkness. Only love can do that." That's why the love story is our driving element. I'm happy we're in the hands of Samuel Goldwyn Films for our American release," says director Wim Wenders.
