

SAMUEL GOLDWYN FILMS ACQUIRES US RIGHTS TO DIRECTOR JÉRÔME SALLE'S 'THE ODYSSEY' (L'ODYSSÉE)

Los Angeles, CA – November 9, 2017 — Samuel Goldwyn Films announced today that they have acquired all U.S. rights to Jérôme Salle's **THE ODYSSEY**. The film stars Lambert Wilson (*OF GODS AND MEN, MATRIX: REVOLUTONS*), Pierre Niney (*FRANTZ, IT BOY*), and Audrey Tautou (*AMELIE, THE DAVINCI CODE, PRICELESS*). The film is scheduled to be released this winter.

THE ODYSSEY was directed by Jérôme Salle. The film was produced by Nathalie Gastaldo Godeau, Philippe Godeau, Olivier Delbosc, and Marc Missonnier. The screenplay was written by Jérôme Salle and Laurent Turner. The deal was negotiated by Peter Goldwyn on behalf of Samuel Goldwyn Films and Eva Diederix of Wild Bunch, on behalf of the filmmakers.
