SAMUEL GOLDWYN FILMS ACQUIRES SCI-FI THRILLER 'PARADISE HILLS' STARRING EMMA ROBERTS & MILLA JOVOVICH

Los Angeles, CA (May 15, 2019) –Samuel Goldwyn Films announced today that the company has acquired North American rights to Alice Waddington's feature directorial debut PARADISE HILLS after its successful premiere at the Sundance Film Festival in January. The sci-fi thriller stars Emma Roberts (NERVE/TV's "American Horror Story"), Danielle Macdonald (PATTI CAKE\$/DUMLPIN'), Awkwafina (CRAZY RICH ASIANS), Jeremy Irvine (MAMMA MIA! HERE WE GO AGAIN), Arnaud Valois (BPM), with Eiza Gonzalez (BABY DRIVER), and Milla Jovovich (THE FIFTH ELEMENT/RESIDENT EVIL).

On an isolated island, Uma (Emma Roberts) wakes up to find herself at Paradise Hills, a facility where high-class families send their daughters to become perfect versions of themselves. The facility is run by the mysterious Duchess (Milla Jovovich) where calibrated treatments including etiquette classes, vocal lessons, beauty treatments, gymnastics and restricted diets, revolve all physical and emotional shortcomings within two months. The outspoken Uma finds solace and friendship in other Paradise Hills residents -- Chloe (Danielle McDonald), Yu (Awkwafina) and Mexican popstar Amarna (Eiza Gonzalez). Uma soon realizes that lurking behind all this beauty is a sinister secret. It's a race against the clock as Uma and her friends try to escape Paradise Hills before it consumes them all.

PARADISE HILLS was directed by Alice Waddington and written by Nacho Vigalondo and Brian Deleeuw. The film was produced by Adrián Guerra and Núria Valls.
