

# DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

The first time I picked up the script for COME AS YOU ARE, it was just past 11pm (that's late for me). I finished it at about 12:30am (trust me, that's a quick read by my standards – but I wasn't tired, my mind was racing). Much like that first read, the process of making this film has felt like a blink of an eye, and, like that first read, it stems from the joy that the script evokes. That joy and se it sure as hell wasn't the easiest movie to make – ipt provided was invaluable and I believe it shows on-

subsequent passion carried us every step of the way, because it sure as hell wasn't the easiest movie to make – nothing with such high ambition is. The currency that the script provided was invaluable and I believe it shows on-screen.

Now, we've all seen road-trip movies. I've read tons of them, too. And there's always going to be movies about guys trying to get laid. But, it became clear to me that that was just the clever wrapper on COME AS YOU ARE. This one resonated with me on a different level. It's the journey of outsiders and underdogs, and I could relate to that on a deeply personal level – I think probably we all can. As a society, we tend to de-sexualize certain groups (Asian American men being one of those groups), and this was a chance to address that head on. Scotty, Matt and Mo's disabilities are physical, but we all survive by our own version of that, be it physical or psychological or even situational. We all have obstacles, and their spirit to experience life, obstacles be damned, is inspiring to me. The message their journey sends transcends ability, race or status – it's the human experience.

Also, it's hilarious.

And so, as the director, I set out to respect the spirit of the story and the characters. It was vital to me and everyone on the film that we had the support and guidance of the disabled community. We partnered with the likes of the Shirley Ryan Ability Lab and the Wheelchair Athletes of McFetridge. But most notably, we had Asta Philpot himself, whose story inspired this movie. Watching him and Grant work together during prep was the moment the whole thing became real for me. Ultimately, that's what I tried to do here. I wanted to keep it real. I wanted all of it to feel real. The characters are real. And the feelings I have for them are real. –RICHARD WONG

Erik Linthorst is a producer, screenwriter and awardwinning documentary filmmaker. His films have screened at dozens of film festivals including Sundance, Edinburgh, Austin, Fantasia, Toronto After Dark, Palm Beach International, Nashville, and many more. Erik's feature film debut, HIGH SCHOOL, starring Academy Award winner Adrien Brody, Golden Globe winner Michael Chiklis, and Colin Hanks was released nationwide theatrically by Anchor Bay films in the summer of 2012, after premiering at the Sundance Film Festival. His documentary film AUTISTIC-LIKE: GRAHAM'S STORY was an official selection at nine US film festivals, and was finalist for the 2009 Freddie Award for outstanding medical and health reporting. It was broadcast nationally on PBS in 2011.

A Chicago native, JJ has produced a diverse collection of very successful independent feature and short films. JJ's feature films have consistently premiered at the industries top festivals, raising their visibility and gaining distribution. JJ's credits include the following projects: THE LONG DUMB ROAD (Sundance, 2018), CHASING THE BLUES (Chicago International Film Festival, 2017), OPERATOR (SXSW, 2016), THE VIEW FROM TALL (LA Film Festival, 2016), and UNEXPECTED (Sundance and SXSW, 2015). JJ has several independent features and TV series in development including the Chicago based comedy "Trivia, Short Life and Edgewater".



# JJ INGRAM PRODUCER

Barrett Stuart has worked in the motion picture industry as an executive in both the studio system and independent arena for nearly 20 years. Through 2003, Mr. Stuart was the Director of Film Finance at Intermedia Film Equities and prior thereto he served in a similar capacity at Paramount Pictures. At both Intermedia and Paramount, Mr. Stuart was responsible for assessing the myriad financing and distribution scenarios contemplated during the green-lighting of a feature film. Since 2004, Mr. Stuart has focused on his dual roles as a film finance consultant and independent producer for BS Productions, Inc. His first feature film, Alison Eastwood's RAILS AND TIES in 2007, was distributed by Warner Bros and starred Kevin Bacon and Marcia Gay Harden. His follow-up, the Mark Neveldine/Brian Taylor (CRANK franchise) scripted PATHOLOGY, which he executive produced along with producer Yan Fisher-Romanovsky, was released by MGM in April of 2008.

# BARRETT STUART PRODUCER



Franklin Leonard is a film producer, cultural commentator, professor, and entrepreneur. He is the founder and CEO of the Black List, the company that celebrates and supports great screenwriting and the writers who do it via film production, its annual survey of best unproduced screenplays, online marketplace, live staged script readings, screenwriter labs, and film culture publications. More than 400 scripts from the annual Black List survey have been produced as feature films earning 250 Academy Award nominations and 50 wins including four of the last ten Best Pictures and ten of the last twenty-two screenwriting Oscars. Franklin has worked in feature film development at Universal Pictures and the production companies of Will Smith, Sydney Pollack and Anthony Minghella, and Leonardo DiCaprio. He has been a juror at the Sundance, Toronto, and Guanajuato Film Festivals and for the PEN Center Literary Awards. He was also a delegate and speaker at the White House's 2015 Global Entrepreneurship Summit in Nairobi, Kenya. He's been one of Hollywood Reporter's 35 Under 35, Black Enterprise magazine's "40 Emerging Leaders for Our Future," The Root's 100 Most Influential African-Americans, and Fast Company's "100 Most Creative People in Business," and was awarded the 2015 African-American Film Critics Association (AAFCA)'s Special Achievement Award for career excellence and the 2019 Writers Guild of America, East Evelyn Burkey award for elevating the honor and dignity of screenwriters. He is an occasional commentator for the BBC and MSNBC on matters of culture, politics, and race, an associate professor at the American Film institute, a trustee of PEN America, an advisor to Glitch, Inc., and a member of the Associates Branch of the Academy of Motion Pictures Arts and Sciences. His TED talk was viewed more than one million times in its first two months of release.



# **FRANKLIN LEONARD EXECUTIVE PRODUCER**

Asta Philpot is an American man living in Leeds (United Kingdom), who was the protagonist of a 2007 BBC One documentary film FOR ONE NIGHT ONLY. He is affected with arthrogryposis, which impairs, since his birth, his physical ability of movement. He advocates the right to an active sexual life for people with disabilities, even if this means paying for sex.

After hearing of a legal brothel with access for wheelchair during a vacation in Spain in 2006, he visited the place and lost his virginity. He found this experience very interesting and decided, therefore, to organize a trip with other people sharing his extreme difficulties in finding a romantic or sexual relationship as a consequence of physical disabilities, advertising his intentions through dedicated Internet forums. Although finding initial resistance to the idea, two other young men, affected with different medical conditions (one legally blind and the other paralyzed in a motorcycle accident) accepted to join the vacation with the purpose to visit the Spanish night club and have the opportunity of a sexual encounter.

A BBC documentary team headed by Producer/Director Jane Beckwith filmed it: the documentary opened some controversies about the opportunity to legalize prostitution in UK, as a means of giving sexual experiences to physically challenged people, who often lack enough social opportunities to build a love relationship, although having a normal social potentiality and normal feelings and sexual needs.

His views contributed to the acclaimed Belgian 2011 film COME AS YOU ARE (original title HASTA LA VISTA), written by Mariano Vanhoof and directed by Geoffrey Enthoven. Asta is thrilled that his story has found its way to the big screen once again.

Rosenmeyer got his start on Broadway in William Shakespeare's MACBETH opposite Kelsey Grammer and Ty Burrell and in longrunning phenom LES MISERABLES before departing for the big screen as one of Ben Stiller's tracksuit- clad sons in Wes Anderson's THE ROYAL TENENBAUMS. He also led the cast of Fox's 2003-2004 series "Oliver Beene." In film, he appeared with George Clooney and Julia Roberts in Jodie Foster's MONEY MONSTER, and starred in indies TEMPS with Lindsey Shaw, and last year's festival film CHASING THE BLUES alongside Jon Lovitz. Rosenmeyer currently recurs on the CW's "Crazy Ex-Girlfriend" and recently wrapped the horror thriller IRL for director Jen Harrington due later this year.

# **GRANT ROSENMEYER** "SCOTTY" + PRODUCER

As just announced, Ravi will be joining the cast of Patty Jenkins and Warner Bros. sequel, WONDER WOMAN 2, opposite Gal Gadot and Chris Pine. He also stars in the indie feature film COME AS YOU ARE, and the Lionsgate feature LONG SHOT opposite Charlize Theron & Seth Rogen, with both films having premiered at SXSW 2019.

Ravi can most recently be seen recurring in ABC's "American Housewife," Aziz Ansari and Alan Yang's critically-acclaimed Netflix series "Master of None," along with TBS's comedy series "Wrecked." Before this, he was a series regular on Danny Chun's FOX show, "Grandfathered," opposite John Stamos and Josh Peck. On the feature side, he can also be seen in the Sundance hit BAND AID, opposite Zoe Lister-Jones and Adam Pally.

In 2014, Ravi wrote, co-directed, and starred in MEET THE PATELS, a documentary that he created with his sister, Geeta Patel, that won the Audience Award for Best Documentary at the LA Film Festival that year. The film portrays Patel's autobiographical journey of trying to find an Indian wife. In 2016, it premiered to rave reviews on Netflix as one of the hottest films across all genres and the high-trending film behind "Making a Murderer." The duo currently have a deal with Fox Searchlight Pictures to adapt the documentary into a feature length film.

Having been cast in pilots nearly every year, Ravi has appeared on numerous popular shows over the course of his career, including but not limited to "It's Always Sunny in Philadelphia," "Scrubs," "Hawaii Five-0," "Grey's Anatomy," "Children's Hospital," and "The Comedians."

Separately from acting, Ravi is the co-founder of This Bar Saves Lives, which donates a meal packet for every granola bar they sell, and is an active investor in several health and wellness start-ups.

He is currently based in LA.

Gabourey Sidibe made her film debut as the title character in Lee Daniels' Academy Award-nominated film, "PRECIOUS: BASED ON THE NOVEL 'PUSH' BY SAPPHIRE"

For her role as "Precious," Sidibe received Academy Award and Golden Globe Award nominations for Best Actress, as well as SAG, Broadcast Film Critics and BAFTA nominations. She won the Independent Spirit Award and an NAACP Image Award for Best Actress, the Breakthrough Performance Award from The National Board of Review and the Vanguard Award at the Santa Barbara International Film Festival.

Sidibe's television credits include memorable roles on several seasons of the Emmy Award-nominated anthology series "American Horror Story," and all seasons of the Golden Globe Award-nominated series "The Big C," opposite Laura Linney. She also recently played the role of 'Denise,' alongside Billy Eichner and Julie Klausner, in all three seasons of Hulu's hilarious "Difficult People." She can currently be seen in her series regular role as 'Becky' on the smash hit series "Empire." In 2010, Sidibe had the distinct honor of hosting "Saturday Night Live."

In addition to PRECIOUS, Sidibe's film credits include Gregg Araki's WHITE BIRD IN A BLIZZARD opposite Shailene Woodley; the action-comedy TOWER HEIST, for director Brett Ratner, opposite Eddie Murphy and Ben Stiller; a cameo appearance in Martin McDonagh's SEVEN PSYCHOPATHS opposite Woody Harrelson; GRIMSBY, opposite Sacha Baron Cohen; LIFE PARTNERS, which premiered at the Tribeca Film Festival; and Victoria Mahoney's independent film, YELLING TO THE SKY, which premiered at the Berlinale Film Festival.

Sidibe made her directorial debut with the short film THE TALE OF FOUR, as part of Refinery29's groundbreaking Shatterbox series. The film won the Audience Award for favorite narrative short at both Urban World and the Black Star Film Festival. Most recently, she directed an episode of "Empire", which is scheduled to air this spring.

Her critically acclaimed first book, "This Is Just My Face: Try Not to Stare," was released in May 2017 by Houghton Mifflin Harcourt.

# **GABOUREY SIDIBE** "SAM"

Hayden Szeto plays Matt in COME AS YOU ARE. Matt is a good-looking kid with a sturdy build, but paralyzed and confined to a wheelchair. After learning that his girlfriend has left him, he agrees to go on an unusual road trip with a rambunctious group of friends.

Hayden first captured the attention of audiences and critics alike with his breakout role in Kelly Fremon-Craig's THE EDGE OF SEVENTEEN. In the film, Hayden stars opposite Hailee Steinfeld as "Erwin," her awkward yet incredibly charming love interest. He garnered attention for his "winning" and "scene-stealing performance," winner of "Rising Star Award" at the Denver Film Festival and was subsequently named as a "New Romantic Lead" in People Magazine's 'Ones to Watch' issue.

In television, he recurs in the upcoming AMC series "Lodge 49" opposite Wyatt Russell, which premiered and was picked up for a 2nd season. He recurred as a guest star in the FX pilot "What We Do in The Shadows," which was picked up to series. He also recently wrapped Catalina Mastretta's pilot for Amazon.

Hayden can be seen in Jeff Wadlow's Blumhouse feature TRUTH OR DARE opposite Lucy Hale, which grossed nearly 100M worldwide. His feature film SUMMER NIGHT was directed by Joe Cross and recently acquired by Samuel Goldwyn Films.
